26. NEW JERSEY SCHOOL WOMEN'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

MUST: Be *female* graduating senior / resident of NJ / be applying for a professional program (minimum baccalaureate) *leading to degree & certification in field of education* / minimum SAT 1460 / academic average B / involvement in extracurricular & academic activities will be considered

AWARD: 3 SCHOLARSHIPS - \$1,000 EACH 2 EDUCATIONAL AWARDS - \$500 EACH

DEADLINE: Complete application **must be POSTMARKED by: MARCH 3, 2017**

27. ESSEX COUNTY SCHOOL NURSES ASSOCIATION

MUST: Be Essex County resident / graduating senior accepted into a *four year nursing program*

AWARD: 2 SCHOLARSHIPS - \$500 EACH

DEADLINE: Complete application packet **must be RECEIVED by: APRIL 19, 2017**

28. MARK GROENDYK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

MUST: Be graduating senior / attend an accredited 2/4 yr coll/univ-level institution next year / have a GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale / submit 500 word essay: *How have your contributions and community service helped to sustain the world we live in?*

AWARD: 2 SCHOLARSHIPS - \$500 EACH

29. NJ SHARING NETWORK FOUNDATION

1. Missy's Miracle Scholarship 2. Betsy Niles Scholarship

MUST: Be graduating senior entering college in the Fall 2017 / be an awareness advocate who is personally affected or is a family member of someone personally affected by an organ and tissue donation and transplantation / be in good academic standing

AWARD: 2 SCHOLARSHIPS - \$5,000 EACH (\$2,500 per semester 2017-18 academic year)

DEADLINE: Complete application **must be POSTMARKED by APRIL 7, 2017**

30. FOSTER and ADOPTIVE FAMILY SERVICES SCHOLARSHIPS

MUST: NJ Foster Care Scholars Program provides funding for eligible youth who have experienced a DCP&P out-of-home placement, DCP&P independent living arrangement, transitional living program homelessness/ seeking a post-secondary education at an accredited 2 or 4 yr coll/univ / vo/tech school

AWARD: UP TO \$5,000 PER ACADEMIC YEAR

DEADLINE: Complete applications **must be RECEIVED by MARCH 15, 2017**
