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## Part I

### Private Diary of FDR Instructions:

During the summer, students in the Honors U.S. History II course will produce a Private Diary for President Roosevelt (FDR). This diary will mainly be based on events addressed during the WWII unit; however, the first five entries will focus on the early years of FDR's presidency: The Great Depression, the Election of 1932, the New Deal, and FDR's views on foreign affairs and the future of the United States. Each diary entry should combine facts with opinions you believe FDR would have had about each event/topic based on your research. Each entry/page is worth 10 points.

The final product should include the following:

- Five diary entries (one full page per entry, 12 font, double-spaced, and a font that looks like a person's hand-writing). The topics include:
  - The Election of 1932
  - The Great Depression
  - The New Deal
  - A problem or issue in Europe prior to WWII
  - The Future of US Foreign Policy Post Pearl Harbor
- Have detailed facts about the event/topic (You may use the internet. If you wish to sign out a textbook, please let Miss Giannotti know- however I can assure you that the textbook will have maybe three pages at best on this topic- well done research will yield better results)
- Combine facts with the opinions/views of FDR
- Be realistic with a correct date and illustrate an understanding of the event and the importance of the event in the context of the time period
- Illustrate time, effort, and creativity
- Have a Works Cited page with at least 5 sources
- Have a cover page with a title, your name, course title, date, and teacher's name.
- Each entry is worth 10 points a piece, and the work cited and cover page are worth 10 points together.
