1. NATIONAL CO-OP SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

MUST: Have a GPA of 3.5 or better on a 4.0 scale / apply and be accepted for 2017-18 academic year at one of the WACE Partner Institutions: Clarkson U; Drexel U; Johnson & Wales U; Merrimack Coll; Rochester Inst. of Tech.; SUNY at Oswego; U of Cincinnati; U Mass. Lowell.; U of Toledo; Wentworth Instit. of Tech.

DEADLINE: Apply on line at www.waceinc.org by **FEBRUARY 15, 2017**

2. HORATIO ALGER ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

MUST: Be full-time HS senior progressing normally toward graduation in 2017 / plan to pursue bachelor's degree at accredited coll in US in fall (may start in 2 yr and transfer to 4 yr) have *critical* financial need (*preferably \$55,000 or lower adjusted gross income per family*) / involvement in co-curricular & community service activities / display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity / minimum GPA of 2.0 / US citizen

AWARD: SCHOLARSHIPS – up to \$25,000

DEADLINE: Completed applications *must be submitted online* - scholars.horatioalger.org
by **OCTOBER 25, 2016**

3. HISPANIC HERITAGE YOUTH AWARDS

MUST: Be graduating senior / of Hispanic/Latino descent / plan to enroll in coll in the fall /US citizen or perm resident / GPA 3.0 on a 4.0 scale / attend awards ceremony if selected

AWARD: GRANTS - UP TO \$3,000

DEADLINE: Applications must be submitted online: www.hispanicheritage.org
by **OCTOBER 2, 2016**

4. BOSTON UNIVERSITY TRUSTEE SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION

MUST: Be graduating senior – rank in the top 5-10% of your class / demonstrate exceptional leadership in school and community

AWARD: FULL TUITION SCHOLARSHIPS FOR FOUR YEARS

APPLY: Apply on line at: bu.edu/admissions/trustee

DEADLINE: Admission Application and 2 Scholarship Essays *must be submitted*
by **DECEMBER 1, 2016**

5. AES ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP

\$500 Scholarship awarded on the basis of character, as determined by an evaluation of essays submitted. Submit an essay between 500 and 1000 words in answer to the following: *When you look back on your life in 30 years, what would it take for you to consider your life successful? What relationships or accomplishments will be important on this journey?* Be sure to include your full name /name of HS / plans for next year. There is no application form.
